HCC makes education affordable to students. Students have the option to pay tuition and fees in full or through installments. HCC's installment payment plan allows students to pay as they go, and at approximately \$850* per semester, college has never been more affordable. The tuition rate for students who reside in the HCC district is \$57 per credit hour. The tuition rate for students who reside outside the HCC district is \$104 per credit hour.

*The cost reflects in-district rate.



With the cost of a college education increasing, HCC not only maintains affordable tuition and fees, but also allows students to choose from a variety of financial aid options to ensure that the education and training they desire is accessible. Grants, loans, work study programs, and scholarships are all available.

HCC's Opportunity 14 Scholarship provides free tuition, fees and books for qualifying students.

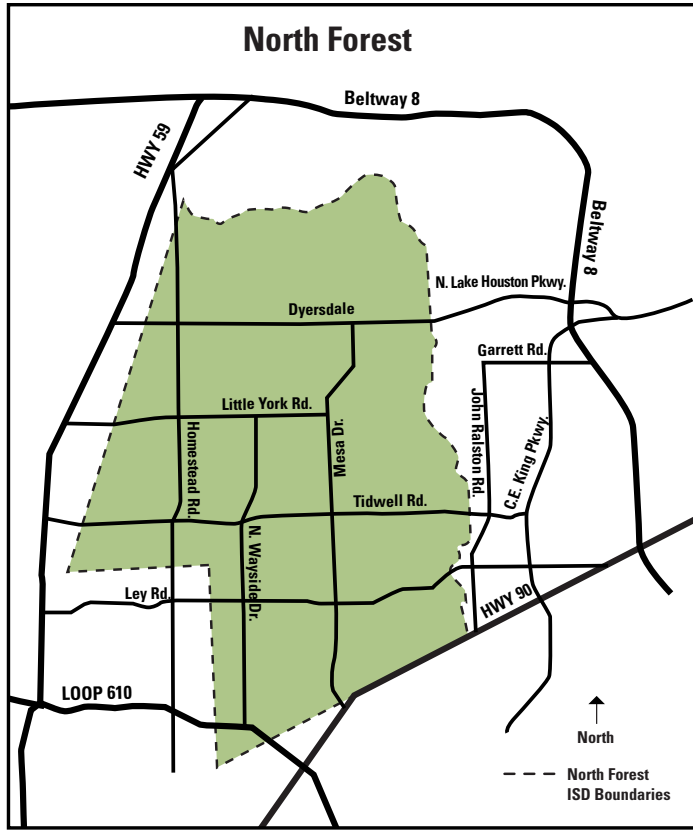

- 1971** HCC is assigned North Forest as a designated Service Area and begins providing quality education and training to North Forest residents in academic, workforce, and continuing education courses.
- 1996** HCC offers Dual Credit classes for NFISD students.
- 1997** HCC renovates the Clifford Tuttle Center, at 8305 Mesa Road.
- 1997** Community visioning sessions begin to gather input and ideas about higher education opportunities in North Forest.
- 2005** HCC and NFISD Trustees approve partnership that allows waivers of Dual Credit courses for NFISD students up to \$76,000 per year in exchange for In-Kind use of North Forest Facilities for instructional programs and services.
- 2009** HCC continues to offer North Forest residents Dual Credit courses, College Options, Traditional College Courses and continuing education.
